

Intermediate – Over 5 and less than 13

Open – 13 or more years experience

General comments

Anyone winning $2 - 1^{st}$ Place awards or BOS in past year(s) moves to next class

Limit of 3 entries in each category (Decid, evergr, trop, indig)

Bonsai purchased or styled by someone other than the owner may be entered for judging 1 year after purchase or styling

After 3 years BOS or 1st Place bonsai may be entered for judging (after next 2 shows)

Any bonsai can be entered for Display only

Best of show, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons except for youth. All get a participation ribbon.


