ummer is coming to a close. If your plants survived the the heat; congratulations! I found that putting carpet under the plants and then placing them in tubs containing Turface was a 'plant savior'. I am planning to do research on this technique next Summer.

Now is the time to be preparing for Winter. We first must know the 'temperature tolerances' of each bonsai plant. I have found that hearty and tropical plants are easier to prepare for, but the 'tender

' bonsai are tricky. Black and Red pines, Chinese elms, Trident maples, and Azaleas can be finicky. I have had discussions about this with Mark Fields, and we agree that 30 degrees is as low as you want to go. Milk House heaters are very affordable and reliable. I have had a pair of them for 10 years, and they keep on working. Programable Outlet heaters are available on line for \$40.

The October meeting will have a conifer workshop. Mark Fields will provide several choices of evergreens. Bring your tools nd some form of table covering. Workshops can get messy! I have been to several other Bonsai clubs and am grateful that we have members who willing and able to provide materials.




