

The Spaan's Shore is in the Pines contort family of pines. The Spaan's has longer branches. Some other known contort 's are the Lodgepole and Shore Pines. Ryan Neal showed a Shore Pine in the 2016 National's and Lee Cheatle of Portland, OR displayed a Lodgepole in 2010. They are common in the Western Cascade Mountain areas. They produce short needles and back bud on old wood. Brus-

sels is selling them, so think of the Brussels trip next March!

I had the privilege of spending a day with Mauro Stemberger. My prior experience was somewhat uncomfortable, but his demeanor has improved. (Perhaps getting married helps a man settle down!). He can be a stickler on wiring; ask Hank Martin or Bob Warfel, but he is genius at "seeing the bonsai design in the tree". If he returns next year, block out the time and bring your most promising tree. Perhaps it will be a Spaan's Shore Pine.


