From the President

irst things first! Prior to the next IBC meeting we have the annual Garfield Park Bonsai Exhibit. June Bonsai Care

(suggestions/considerations)

Outdoor

Watering: Once a day or maybe even twice a day.

Fertilizing: Once a week at full strength

Pruning: Do not prune.

Potting: Do not repot.

Wiring: Only wire evergreens.

Location: All bonsai can come out of winter protection. Rotate pots every week.

Indoor

Watering: No more submerging until next year. Water as needed (even everyday if need be), but do not water if soil is moist. Misting everyday is recommended.

Fertilizing: Once a week at full strength

Pruning: Prune branches that overgrew in spring.

Potting: Avoid repotting.

Wiring: Alright.

Location: Can be placed outdoors if weather is good. Protect from wind and keep rotating.
