#### From the President

t's almost State Fair Time! As I'm writing this monthly president's message, we are two weeks out from setting up the Indiana State Fair Bonsai Show. Setup for the show will take place on July 29th. The Show runs from Friday, July 30th through Sunday, August 8th. We will be picking up our trees before noon on Monday, August 9th. This year, the fair will be closed on Mondays and Tuesdays. This show is open to all residents of Indiana, but the Indianapolis Bonsai Club hosts the show. By that, I mean that IBC members take care of watering the trees and manning the booth while the bonsai are on display. We'll need help for setup and for manning the booth. Furthermore, I'm hoping that we have many people participating by bringing trees for display. This could be your chance to go home with a state fair ribbon!

As I stated at the last meeting: Have fun! Don't be intimidated! Don't be afraid to show your trees. All trees are a work in progress and trees are judged in several different classes. The novice bonsai artist isn't competing against the seasoned veteran. Displaying your tree at a show is a good thing. It will help you improve as a bonsai artist. If you are new to this...don't worry...we're here to help.

First of all, you really just need to focus on the basics. Get the weeds out of the pot. Clean your pot. Dress up your surface soil. Clean out dead leaves. Trim it up. After that, you can think about things like stands and accents. If you don't have a suitable stand, you can always improvise with a bamboo placemat. Find a suitable accent stone or plant. You can surf the internet for pictures of bonsai shows to get ideas. You can also contact one of the local bonsai vendors. They may be able to help with accessories or give you pointers on your display. You can also come on the setup day and get some help from one of the veteran club members. We'll be tweaking the display and moving trees around throughout the morning and early afternoon. Although I like to see trees come in from all over the state, it is still my hope that we have plenty of participation from our own club members. Maybe someone from Evansville can complain about Indianapolis being too far away to participate, but most IBC club members don't have that excuse. The fairgrounds shouldn't be too out of the way for most of us.

Originally, the topic for the August meeting was, 'Preparing your Tree for the Indiana State Fair.' The State Fair Board then decided to back the fair's start date up a week. This happened months after our schedule was published, so we needed to make some changes. Therefore, I will not be at the August meeting. I'll be working the bonsai show at the State Fair. August meeting will be run by our capable Vice President, Alyssa Batula. The August meeting will focus on conifer bonsai. Former IBC President (and current ABS President), Mark Fields, will be conduct a program on wiring conifers, followed by a conifer wiring workshop. I'm sure that it will be an excellent presentation. I'm hoping that we have excellent attendance for the August meeting. I'm also hoping that you can find some time during the first week of August to see bonsai show at the Indianapolis State Fair. You can enjoy the bonsai show, then go out and get yourself an elephant ear.
