From the President



ell, summer is coming to a close and we need to be thinking about fall prep for our trees. Before I start talking about that kind of stuff, I want to touch on what has been a pretty busy September.

First of all, we had a great annual auction during our September meeting. I thought we had a good crowd and there were many trees and pots that went to new homes. Thanks again to our auctioneers Paul Weishaar and Rob Pugh and also to Bob Hoy and Steve Dick for running the very busy money and membership table. The second weekend of September was also very busy. The annual Penrod Art Fair was on Saturday, September 11. This tends to be one of the larger fund raisers for the club and we managed to sell about 70 trees that day. Also, the US National Bonsai Exhibition was taking place that same weekend in Rochester, New York. IBC members Mark Fields, Greg Madson, Hank Martin and Scott Yelich all had trees on display at the National Exhibition. You can see pictures of the trees belonging to IBC members at the National Exhibition in this newsletter.

Now that we're almost into October, we need to think about what we are going to be doing with our tropical bonsai. Personally, I like to keep my tropical trees above 50F. Usually, I get things ready in advance, but I don't normally move my trees until a day or two before I really have to. I have to move about 200 or so tropical trees, so I tend to put if off for as long as I can. For me, the first main task is getting the greenhouse cleaned and ready. Most of my trees go there, but right now, my greenhouse is a bit of a mess. All of the trees have been out of there since mid May and it has become a yard barn full of boxes and yard equipment. I need to clean the junk out, weed it, wash down the walls, and move my benches back inside. After that, I'll be ready for the move. I also bring some trees inside. Some go in my picture window and others go down in my basement under fluorescent growing lights. If I'm using artificial lighting for my trees, I normally keep my lights on for 14-16 hours a day. I really don't worry about Winterizing my deciduous and evergreen trees until early November, so I'll talk more about that process next month.

Obviously, there is still a lot to do this time of the year when it comes to maintaining our trees. Besides moving the tropical trees to warmer areas, now is also a great time to work on wiring and cleaning up the conifer trees. The feature presentation for our October meeting will be a conifer workshop presented by bonsai artist, Mark Fields. You can purchase trees from Mark for the workshop. The club will provide wire for training the trees. We will NOT be repotting these trees. Although fall is the perfect time to wire conifer trees, you will want to wait and pot them in the Spring.


