
Demonstration on how to maintain and care for your tools was done by Rob Pugh. Rob covered cleaning and sharpening

Treasurer Steve Dick

Hi, I am Steven Dick, the newly elected Treasurer for IBC. I started in Bonsai in the mid 1980's but after killing several trees, I gave up. Then in 2010, I saw the Club's display at the State Fair and decided to give it another try. This time I actually tried to learn about the different types of trees so I could grow trees suited for where I was actually going to grow them. I built a small 5' x 12' hot house onto my condo to winter my trees. I started with a \$200 Fukien Tea I bought down in GA; but that winter an ice storm pulled the translucent roof off my greenhouse and froze my prized tree. I corrected my structural issue and started again, albeit with somewhat less expensive trees. I have chosen to grow primarily tropicals, succulents, and a couple deciduous. I am one of those fools who love trees with needles. Now in my 15th year I have 10-12 show trees and about 35-40 others in varying stages of development. I have tried to be active in the club - helping with our shows, being the volunteer coordinator (a tough job twisting arms to get you involved), and the membership coordinator. I have found that short of apprenticing with an experienced bonsai master; being involved, talking with guests coming to our shows, and displaying trees, even small trees, is the fastest way to learn. Accordingly, while I serve you as the Club Treasurer, I strongly encourage you to be involved. This is your club; and we grow and succeed based upon your involvement!
